

Positively Living was established in 1997 to serve as a day center in order to assist in the care of those living with HIV. Since then the needs of the community have grown and medications have become more effective. In response to these changing needs, the company launched Choice Health Network in 2017. Today we are an organization of 40 staff with an annual budget of close to 6 million dollars.

While treatment options have expanded there is no cure for HIV. Close to 40,000 Americans are still diagnosed each year, over half of all new infections occur here in the South.

We offer a full array of medical, mental health and case management services, utilizing a structurally competent, trauma informed care model.
